Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois says that on October 22, 2011, Saturday afternoon at approximately 2:00 p.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to Al's Trailer Park in Gray in reference to a shooting. Deputies then learned that there were two men shot during this incident.

A 17 year old victim was transported to Terrebonne General Hospital where he was treated for a gunshot wound to the shoulder and leg. A 20 year old victim was transported to Thibodaux Regional Hospital where he was treated for a gunshot wound to his back.



Junius Vergin

The suspect, Junius Vergin Jr., was located at 117 Sheila Court which is within Al's Trailer Park. Vergin was transported to the Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office where he was questioned by detectives. Detectives arrested Junius Vergin Jr., age-25, 126 Polk St. Houma, for two counts attempted first degree murder. Vergin remains in the Terrebonne Parish Jail on a \$500,000.00 bond.

The 20 year old victim was released from the hospital on Sunday; however, the 17 year old victim remains hospitalized in critical condition.

T.P.S.O detectives have obtained arrest warrants on three additional suspects for two counts of attempted first degree murder. The suspects are as follows: Desmond Deonta Holden, age-19, 1231 Goode St. Houma, Maurice Gregory Banks, age-19, 800 Winder Rd. Thibodaux and Tye Juan Aubert, age-25, address unknown.

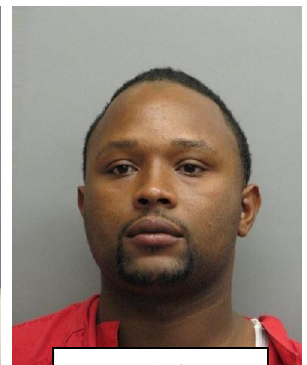
