A local man wanted for the attempted murder of another was arrested in Lafourche parish Thursday night, Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said.

Alvin Campbell, 22, was arrested by warrant at 3917 Hwy 1 at a house currently being live in by his mother and other family members.

An arrest warrant was issued for Campbell in July for the May 4th shooting of a Schriever man. The shooting incident occurred on Hue Street in Schriever and resulted from a botched drug deal between the two men. One suspect was arrested one week after the shooting and through investigation, detectives learned of Campbell's involvement. Warrants were issued, but law enforcement had been unable to locate him to date. Detectives received an anonymous tip Thursday afternoon regarding Campbell's location. TPSO detectives met with Lafourche Parish Sheriff's Office detectives and arranged to apprehend Campbell.

Campbell was arrested inside the residence at approximately 9:00 p.m. Thursday night. He was booked at the Lafourche Detention Center and then released into the custody of TPSO officials. He was subsequently booked at the Terrebonne Parish Criminal Justice Complex for one count of attempted first degree murder. His bond is set at \$300,000.
