News Release

June 16, 2011



On June 7, 2011, Tuesday, the mother of a 14 year old female reported her daughter missing to the Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office. The mother advised deputies that her daughter had left walking from a residence on Everette Dr. on Saturday, June 4, 2011 at approximately 10:00 p.m. She was spending the night at this residence with some friends. The mother informed deputies that she had been searching for her daughter on her own because someone in the public told her that she could not report her daughter missing until after 24 hours.

After the mother filed the report with the Sheriff's Office she created fliers and posted them around the Houma area. Detectives and deputies followed up on tips that were provided to the Sheriff's Office and to the mother. The mother received information on the location of where her daughter was staying and she did not report this information to the detectives.

On June 9, 2011, Monday the 14 year old juvenile returned home. Detectives received information that the juvenile had been staying at a residence with a 20 year old man who is identified as Rene Boudreaux Jr. Detectives questioned Boudreaux who admitted to allowing the juvenile to stay at his residence; however, he said that she told him that she was 17 years of age.

On June 13, 2011, Monday detectives arrested Rene Paul Boudreaux Jr., age-20, 201 Columbus St. Houma for felony carnal knowledge of a juvenile, oral sexual battery, contributing to the delinquency of a juvenile and illegal use of a controlled dangerous substance in the presence of persons under 17 years of age. Boudreaux remains in the jail on a \$100,000.00 bond.

Detectives issued Boudreaux's mother, Lisa Kay Breaux, age-45, 201 Columbus St. Houma a misdemeanor summons for encouraging / contributing to child delinquency and illegal use of a control dangerous substance in the presence of a person under 17 years of age.

On June 15, 2011, Wednesday detectives issued the juvenile's mother Crystal Woods, 31, 146 Dixie Ave. Houma, a misdemeanor summons for improper supervision of a juvenile. The juvenile faces charges of being a runaway.
