News Release

On April 17, 2011, Sunday morning at approximately 12:55 a.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to the HMS Court in Broadmoor Subdivision in reference to a burglary in progress. Deputies arrived in the area of the victim's residence and observed the suspect running through the yards of the neighbors.

Deputies chased the suspect through the neighborhood and during this time a neighbor heard someone running through his backyard and yelled at the suspect. Deputies were able to apprehend the suspect in the backyard of this residence and take him into the custody without incident. Deputies recovered a back pack that contained personal items that were stolen from the victim's residence. After conducting an inventory of this back pack it was discovered there were items inside of this back pack that was stolen from the victim's vehicle and residence such as a GPS, tools, an I-pod, compact disc player and a school tablet etc.

The suspect is identified as Brad Joseph Bourg, age-22, 257 Robert St. Houma. Bourg was arrested for simple burglary of an inhabited dwelling and simple burglary. After further investigation it was learned that Bourg stole a pair of shoes from a neighbors' resident and a bicycle from another residence within this subdivision; therefore, Bourg was also arrested for theft and criminal trespassing.

Bourg was booked into the Terrebonne Parish Criminal Justice complex where he remains on a \$21,500.00 bond; his arraignment date is set for June 13, 2011.
