News Release

Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois says that on February 7, 2011, Monday morning at approximately 10:00 a.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to the 421 Champion St. Gray in reference to a residential burglary. A witness provided deputies with a description of the suspects.

Deputies arrived on scene and made contact with the suspect who was walking on the street in front of 421 Champion St. When deputies made contact with the suspect he gave them a fake name; however, after the deputies were able to obtain his real identity which is Charlton Henry it was learned that there were arrest warrants for his arrest for failure to appear in court. Henry was immediately placed under arrest.

Deputies then continued with the investigation regarding the burglary of the residence. The witness informed deputies that the suspect took a brick and broke a window on the mobile home. Then, after the suspect made entry there was a loud noise as though property inside of the mobile home was being destroyed.

Deputies made entry into the mobile home and observed that the stove and furniture had been flipped over, ceiling fans had been ripped from the ceiling and the toilet was broken with water running uncontrollably throughout the trailer.

Deputies were later contacted by the owner of the rental properties. He informed the deputies that he owned the mobile homes located at 421 and 423 Champion St. Gray. The owner advised that his tenants recently moved out of the mobile homes and the property was not in the same condition that it was when they left. He also stated that there was a 42" plasma television, play station 3 and an I-pod docking station missing from the trailer.

Deputies arrested Charlton Jordan Henry, age-20, 416 Champion St. Gray for simple burglary of an inhabited dwelling and simple criminal to property. He was also arrested on the arrest warrants for failure to appear for illegal possession of stolen property. Henry remains in jail on a \$50,000.00 bond.
