



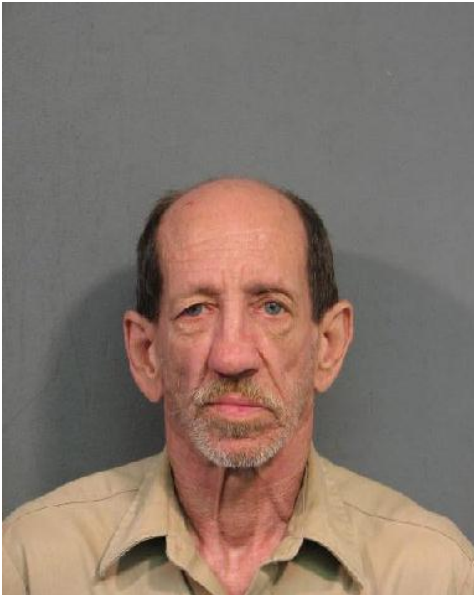

News Release

March 22, 2011



On March 21, 2011, Monday evening at approximately 4:45 p.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies and detectives responded to 120 Tony Crochet Court in reference to burglary of a shed in progress.

Deputies and detectives arrived on scene to learn that the suspect, who was the neighbor, had already exited the shed and returned to his residence. Deputies made contact with the resident who described two boxes of items that were stolen from the shed.

Detectives went to 122 Tony Crochet Court and made contact with the suspect who is indentified as Curtis John Liner Sr. Liner was in possession of the stolen items reported stolen from the victim's shed. The stolen items were two Direct Television receivers and some electrical wiring. The items were recovered from inside of Liner's mobile home.

The victim of this burglary also informed detectives that approximately one month prior to this date there was a vehicle burglary that occurred at this same location. During this burglary the victim's company vehicle was burglarized and there was a tool bag which contained miscellaneous tools and a multi-meter circuit tester stolen.

Detectives questioned Liner regarding this burglary and he confessed to committing this burglary as well. Curtis John Liner Sr., age-64, 122 Tony Crochet Court Houma was arrested on two counts of simple burglary and on an arrest warrant for failure to appear in court.

Liner remains in the Terrebonne Parish jail on a \$10,500.00 bond; his arraignment date is set for April 21, 2011.
