Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois says that on September 28, 2010, Tuesday afternoon at 12:20 p.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to the 100 block of Manchester Dr. in reference to theft of a purse from inside of a vehicle.

Deputies arrived at this location and made contact with the caller. The caller advised that she placed her mother's purse on the front of her vehicle, leaving the front passenger door opened, while she walked back to the house. The suspect then drove into the driveway and parked next to the opened door and exited his vehicle. He walked around in the area of the victim's vehicle. The suspect then re-entered his vehicle and left the scene. The complainant immediately went back to their vehicle and noticed the purse was missing from the front seat.

During this investigation deputies learned that Danny Harris had been washing vehicles for several residents in the subdivision and fits the description of the suspect. Deputies later made contact with Harris on Manchester Dr. The deputies questioned him and he denied the allegations. Danny Lee Harris, b/m age 45, 400 Westside Boulevard Houma was arrested on arrest warrants for failure to appear in court.

Deputies continued this investigation and later arrested Harris for theft and vehicle trespassing; Harris remains in jail on a \$2,500.00 bond.
