A Houma man was arrested for shooting his neighbor Saturday night, Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said.

Terrebonne Parish Sheriff Office deputies and detectives responded to Rembert Trailer Court off of Coteau Road at approximately 8:15 p.m. in reference to a disturbance involving several male subjects. Residents in the area reported hearing shots fired. Upon the arrival of officers, a subject was found with a gunshot wound to the back. The victim, along with several subjects in the area immediately identified a resident of the trailer park as the subject who engaged in an argument with the victim and fired several shots from a shotgun.

The investigation revealed that the victims were having a gathering at #7 Cindy Court when Alvin Delaune, 39 of #5 Cindy Court became agitated with the noise level of the gathering and began racking a shotgun in his yard in the direction of the victims. The victims attempted to leave the area in their vehicle when Delaune began chasing them and shooting a shotgun at them. Shots struck the victim's vehicle shattering the rear window, front windshield and tailgate. One of the rounds entered the vehicle and struck the driver.

Upon the arrival of deputies and a Louisiana State Police trooper, Delaune was immediately detained with a shotgun in his possession. The victim, a 30 year old male, was treated at Terrebonne General Medical Center for injuries from the shotgun. Several pellets from the shotgun embedded in his back. He was treated and released.

Delaune was also treated at TGMC after complaining of back pain. While being treated at TGMC, Delaune attacked a TPSO detective.

Delaune was ultimately charged with three counts of attempted first degree murder, battery on a police officer and resisting an arrest. He was transported to the Terrebonne Parish Criminal Justice Complex where he was booked and jailed. He awaits a bond hearing.

Delaune has a previous criminal history for second degree battery.
