



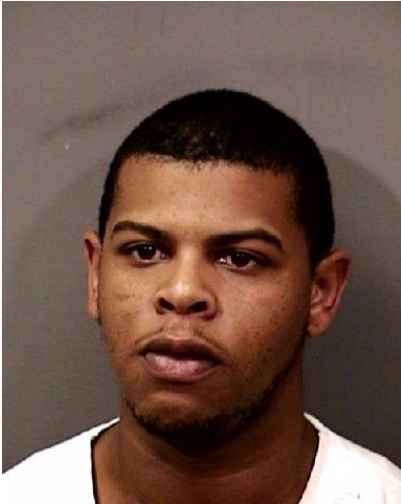

News Release

On March 31, 2011, Thursday night, at approximately 11:50 p.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to the 3600 block of Baker Dr. in reference to telephone harassment. The 24 year old female victim informed deputies that her ex-boyfriend, Deshawn Sheppard, refused to stop calling her residence. There were warrants for Sheppard's arrest for cyber stalking, domestic abuse battery, unauthorized entry into an inhabited dwelling and telephone harassment on previous incidents involving the same victim.

Deputies arrived at this location and observed Sheppard lying in the victim's front yard on the ground beneath the bushes. Deputies order Sheppard to come out with his hands up and he refused. Sheppard then got up and ran from the deputies and there was a brief chase before deputies caught him. Deputies had a brief struggle with Sheppard before handcuffing him.

Deputies arrested Sheppard for telephone harassment, criminal trespassing and resisting an officer. He was also arrested on the arrest warrants for cyber stalking, domestic abuse battery, unauthorized entry into an inhabited dwelling and telephone harassment.

Deshawn Michael-James Sheppard, age-24, 5164 Barrow St., Convent, La. remains in the Terrebonne Parish Jail on a \$100,00.00 bond; his arraignment date is set for May 5, 2011.
