## News Release

January 18, 2011



On January 14, 2011, Friday night, at approximately 7:50 p.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to the Bayou Gardens Mini Storages, 807 Bayou Gardens Boulevard Houma, in reference to a robbery.

Deputies arrived on scene and made contact with the father of the 15 year old victim. The victims in this matter were ages 14 and 15. The victim's father stated that his son told him that he and his friend were walking home on Southland Circle, from the Southland Mall, when they were robbed by two white male suspects. The father stated that he, his son and the 14 year old victim got into his vehicle and began riding and looking for the suspects.

While an off duty deputy was passing the Bayou Gardens Mini Storages he noticed two subjects riding bicycles to the back of the mini storages and a truck followed them. When the deputy made contact with the driver of the pick-up truck he told him that these were the suspects who robbed his son and his friend. The father stated that the suspects stole his son cell phone and \$5 from his friend. The deputy working this area was called and he responded to this location.

Deputies questioned the 17 year old suspect, who was identified as Dustin Rodrigue, age-17, and he admitted to robbing the two victims. Deputies searched Rodrigue and located the stolen cell phone his pants pocket.

Deputies arrested Dustin Rodrigue, age-17, 502 Champagne Court Chauvin, La. and the 16 year old juvenile suspect for simple robbery. The 16 year old juvenile was transported to the Terrebonne Parish Juvenile Justice Complex.

Rodrigue was transported to the Terrebonne Parish Jail where he was booked for simple robbery. Deputies later learned that when deputies made contact with Rodrigue he was riding a stolen bicycle. On January 16, 2011, Sunday evening Rodrigue was charged with possession of stolen property. Rodrigue remains in the Terrebonne Parish jail on a \$23,000.00 bond.
