News Release

February 23, 2011



On February 22, 2011, Tuesday morning 7:07 a.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to the St. Joseph's Church, 5232 La. Highway 56 Chauvin, in reference to a burglary. Deputies and detectives arrived at this location and learned that there was forced entry into the church. There was a Dodge Ram 1500 pick-up truck stolen along with a lawn mower, pressure washer, generator, refrigerator and a projection screen television.

Later during the morning the Houma Police Department responded to 121 4th St. in reference to a suspicious vehicle parked behind the residence. H.P.D arrived at this location and learned that the vehicle was reported stolen from the St. Joseph's Church earlier during the day. T.P.S.O detectives then responded to this location and learned that the other items reported stolen from the church was located in a shed behind the residence. Detectives recovered these items after executing a search warrant. Detectives received information that a silver colored Mitsubishi Galant was seen leaving this residence during

the time of the suspicious activity.

T.P.S.O detectives continued their investigation and received information that the suspects were possibly at an unknown address on Poplar St. in Thibodaux. Detectives followed this lead and located the Mitsubishi Galant parked in front of 603 Poplar St. occupied by Ty Fischer and Megan Besson. Fischer and Besson were transported to the Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office where detectives questioned them.

During the questioning of Fischer and Besson they confessed to committing this burglary together. Detectives were also able to recover a communion plate from the trunk of Fisher's vehicle.

Ty Michael Fischer, age-18, 244 Blakefield Dr. Schriever and Megan Elizabeth Besson, age 17, Besson 603 Poplar St. Thibodaux were arrested for simple burglary and transported to the Terrebonne Parish Jail. Fischer remains in jail on a \$150,000.00 bond while Besson remains in jail on a \$25,000.00 bond. The couple's arraignment date is set for April 7, 2011.
