News Release

Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois states that after several months of investigating the Hue St. shooting Terrebonne Parish detectives have identified a second suspect. TPSO detectives have obtained a warrant for attempted first degree murder for Alvin Campbell, b/m, date of birth 12-21-1987, 202 Carol St. Thibodaux, La.

The shooting was reported to the T.P.S.O. on May 4, 2010, Tuesday morning at approximately 7:05 a.m. Deputies arrived on scene and located the victim of this shooting lying in the ditch. The 26 year old male, who is a resident of Thibodaux, was shot once in the left forearm and once in the upper left thigh. Acadian Ambulance transported the victim to a local hospital to be treated for his injuries. The victim was later released from the hospital.

The information provided to detectives indicates that this altercation started in the Marydale Subdivision. During this investigation detectives learned that the victim was walking on La. 3185 from the Marydale Subdivision when he was chased, through the open field, to Hue St. The victim was running from the suspects when he attempted to enter a residence in the 100 block of Hue St. The door of the residence was locked and the victim was unable to make entry into the residence. After the shooting occurred the two black male suspects entered two vehicles and left the scene. One suspect entered an older model blue vehicle and the second suspect entered an older model white colored vehicle.

On May 13, 2010, detectives arrested the first suspect, Rickie Campbell, age-36, of 202 Carol St. Thibodaux for attempted first degree murder. Rickie remains in the Terrebonne Parish Jail on a \$250,000.00 bond.
