Three men were arrested Friday morning in connection with two incidents at the Terrebonne Parish Criminal Justice Complex, Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said.

Joshua Calloway, 20 of 220 Cherbourg Street in Houma, was charged with sexual battery in connection with an incident that occurred inside a fellow inmate's cell at approximately 9:30 p.m. Thursday night.

Witness and victim accounts indicate that Calloway attacked a fellow inmate inside of his cell by forcefully inserting a foreign object into the victim's anus. It was not reported to correctional officers at that time.

A second incident occurred later that night involving Calloway and two other inmates identified as James Davis, 26, of 112 Faith Trailer Court and Nicholas Little, 20 of 300 Stovall Street. All three men reportedly rushed into the cell of another inmate. Once inside the cell, the suspects tore the victim's clothing and fondled his private parts. This incident was stopped when correctional officers observed the disturbance and intervened.

The victim of the first incident received medical attention. He was treated at Chabert Hospital and later released. He did not suffer any major physical injury. The victim of the second incident did not require any medical attention.

All suspects were placed in confinement cells and segregated from the remaining jail population.

Calloway was charged with two counts of sexual battery. Davis was charged with one count of sexual battery and Little was charged with one count of simple battery.

Calloway was already incarcerated at TPCJC for second degree battery; Davis was incarcerated for several counts of simple burglary; Little was incarcerated for attempted first degree murder. All suspects await a bond hearing.
