News Release

August 30, 2010



Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said that on August 29, 2010, Sunday night approximately 9:30 p.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to a stabbing at 212 St. Louis St. Deputies Arrived at this location and learned that there was a fight between two males and one of them was stabbed multiple times.

Deputies entered the residence and made contact with the victim who was lying on the floor bleeding from his back and was unresponsive. The residents informed deputies that there was fight between the 27 year old victim and the suspect who is identified as Jason Este.

Bayou Cane first responders arrived on scene and assessed the victim's injuries and within a short time frame Acadian Ambulance arrived. Acadian Ambulance then rendered aid to the victim on scene before transporting him to the Terrebonne General Hospital. The victim received five stab wounds to his arm, back and side.

Detectives arrived on scene in order to assist the deputies with this investigation. Jason Este was transported to the Sheriff's Office for questioning regarding this investigation. Detectives learned that prior to this incident both the victim and suspect had been consuming alcoholic beverages. Este is the boyfriend of the victim's mother and they all reside at 212 St. Louis St. The information obtained during this investigation is that this had been an ongoing feud between the two.

Detectives learned that Este and the victim were involved in a verbal argument that turned into a physical confrontation when Este stabbed the victim several times with a pair of scissors. The victim remains in the hospital in stable condition and his injuries does not appear to be life threatening at this time.

Jason Michael Este, age-27, 212 St. Louis St. Houma was arrested for attempted 2nd degree murder. Este was booked into the Terrebonne Parish Jail where he remains on a \$150,000.00 bond.
