## News Release

The Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office detectives arrested a Houma man for theft of a motor vehicle on Monday, Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said.

On 08-30-10, a Houma resident allowed Jermaine Netters, 26, of 330 American Boulevard to test drive his vehicle that he had posted for sale. The vehicle was a 2003 Ford Crown Victoria. When Netters returned the vehicle minutes later, he apparently returned it with an alternate key. The victim did not realize that at the time. Two days later, the victim noticed that his vehicle was missing from his driveway and then realized that Netters had returned the car with a key that did not belong to his vehicle. Upon reporting his car stolen to TPSO, deputies from the patrol division and as well as detectives located Netters in the victim's vehicle on 09-27-10 at

330 American Boulevard. Netters not only had possession of the victim's vehicle and the original key, but had also changed the vehicle's VIN plate.

Netters was arrested and charged with theft of a motor vehicle. He remains at the Terrebonne Parish Criminal Justice Complex on a \$10,000 bond. Netters has previous criminal history including theft and burglary.
