Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois says that Terrebonne Parish detectives solved vehicle burglaries that occurred in the Ellendale Subdivision. The vehicle burglaries were reported to the Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office on Saturday, October 2, 2010. Deputies responded to seven vehicle burglaries in the 200 and 300 block of Joshua Reed Dr. Houma.

All of the vehicles were unlocked and there was not any forced entry. The items that were stolen from the interior of the vehicles consist of cell phones, I-pods, keys, check books, speakers, stereo equipment etc.

After the deputies investigated these complaints all of the weekend detectives continued with this investigation on Monday. Detectives continued this investigation which led to three suspects who are all from the Morgan City area. Two of the three suspects were originally arrested on unrelated charges in the Morgan City area. The following three suspects are all incarcerated in the St. Mary Parish Jail on seven counts of simple burglary.

2. Broderick Demond Junifer, b/m, age-21, 1410 Federal Ave. Morgan City.
