Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois says that on November, 28, 2010, Sunday night at approximately 11:05 p.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to the 200 block of Kenneth St. in reference to an attempted burglary in progress.

Deputies arrived at this location to find that the home owner caught the suspect attempting burglarizing his garage and held him there until the deputies arrived. Deputies made contact with the victim who informed them that his wife told him that she looked outside and saw their neighbor attempting to break into their garage. The victim then exits their residence and caught the suspect attempting to leave his property by jumping the fence. The victim grabbed the suspect and detained him until the deputies arrived.

After the deputies arrived they made contact with the suspect and questioned him regarding the attempted burglary. He confessed to attempting to break into the neighbor's garage. He stated that he needed rolling papers to roll and smoke synthetic marijuana; furthermore, that he knew that the neighbors roll their own cigarettes and kept rolling papers in the garage. Deputies recovered a screw driver that the suspect had in his possession that was used as a burglary tool.

Deputies arrested Kaz James Boudreaux, age 21, 227 Kenneth St. Houma for attempted simple burglary and possession of tools for a burglary. Boudreaux was transported to the Terrebonne Parish Jail where he was booked and jailed.
