Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said that on August 13, 2011, Saturday morning at approximately 8:30 a.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to the intersection of St. Louis Canal Rd. and Westside Boulevard in reference to a hit and run accident involving a pedestrian.

Deputies arrived at this location and made contact with the complainant. She informed deputies that she and her son were driving by this location when they noticed the victim lying in the ditch. The victim was covered with mud and grass and was missing one of her shoes. The victim was in obvious pain and was not able to answer very many questions asked by the deputy. The victim is identified as Kim Landry, age-42, 700 Kenny St. Houma, La.

During this investigation deputies learned that Landry left her residence earlier during the morning to take a morning jog and that she was jogging on the Westside Blvd. Houma when this incident occurred.

Acadian Ambulance transported Landry to Terrebonne General Hospital where she received medical attention. Landry suffered with a broken right jaw, fractured ribs and right shoulder. She was also bleeding from her brain.

Landry was later transported to a Baton Rouge Hospital where she underwent surgery. Landry remains hospitalized in critical condition at this time.
