News Release



February 1, 2012

On January 29, 2012, Sunday morning at approximately 11:00 a.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to the 200 block of Capri Court in reference to a disturbance. Deputies arrived on scene and learned that a domestic altercation had occurred prior to their arrival and that the suspect had left the area.

Deputies spoke with a 16 year old female who informed deputies that her 26 year old sister and her 30 year old husband, Lance Trahan, was involved in an argument before Trahan pulled her sister's hair and knocked her to the floor. The 16 year old female said that when she attempted to call the Sheriff's Office Trahan pinned her against the wall and attempted to take her cell phone in order to prevent her from making the call.

Next, after the parents and the victims brother arrived on Capri Trailer Court the suspect, Lance Trahan, was attempting to leave Carpi Court. The 23 year old brother of the victims was attempting to flag down Trahan as he was leaving in a grey in color Dodge Ram Truck. Trahan allegedly struck the brother with the truck and he was knocked to the ground and was unconscious. He was then transported to the Terrebonne General Hospital where he was treated for a fractured collar bone.

Deputies patrolled the area in search of Trahan but were unable to locate him. Then, on January 31, 2012, Tuesday night Trahan reported to the Sheriff's Office and turned himself in to a deputy.

Lance Gared Trahan, age-30, 200 Capri Court Houma was arrested for domestic abuse battery (2nd offense), simple battery and aggravated second degree battery. Trahan remains in the Terrebonne Parish Jail on a \$100,000.00 bond.
