A large disturbance Monday evening led to the arrest of a Crozier man, Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said.

Patrol deputies responded to several complaints between 6:30 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. in reference to several subjects causing disturbances in the Crozier area. The anonymous callers also reported that the unknown suspect(s) were shooting firearms in the area.

Patrol deputies were unable to locate any suspects during the initial calls, however, after receiving a third 911 call, deputies responded and learned that a subject, identified as Prentiss Lee Livas, 27, of 106 Edgewater Drive, had fired several rounds from a handgun into a vehicle occupied by four adults and a 2 year-old child. The rounds struck the vehicle. No one was injured.

The cause of the argument between Livas and the victims is unknown at this time.

Livas was apprehended during the investigation. He was subsequently arrested and charged with five counts of aggravated assault with a firearm, aggravated criminal damage to property and illegal discharge of a firearm. He was transported to the Terrebonne Parish Criminal Justice Complex where he was booked and jailed. He remains there on a \$150,000 bond.

Livas has an extensive criminal history including carnal knowledge of a juvenile, resisting arrest, and aggravated assault.
