Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois says that on September 8, 2010, Wednesday morning at approximately 11:15 a.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to a residential burglary in the 3700 block of La. Highway 316 Gray, La.

Deputies arrived at this location and contacted a witness who observed the suspect leaving the area of the victim's residence. Afterwards deputies were contacted by the owner of the residence. The owner conducted an inventory of the residence and informed the deputy the following items were missing: three air conditioner window units, a lawn mower, fishing poles and a gas can. Deputies patrolled the area but were unable to locate the suspect.

T.P.S.O detectives continued this investigation and later received the name of the suspect responsible for this burglary. After further investigation the suspect was positively identified as Michael Johnson.

Johnson was picked up by detectives and transported to the Sheriff's Office where detectives questioned him; Johnson confessed to committing this burglary.

On September 16, 2010, Thursday morning, Detectives arrested Michael Lee Johnson, age-31, 3090 West Main St. Gray, for simple burglary and criminal trespassing. He was transported to the Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office where he was booked and jailed. Johnson remains in the Terrebonne Parish Jail on a \$200,000.00 bond; his arraignment date is set for October 28, 2010.
