## News Release



February 1, 2012

On January 31, 2012, Tuesday Terrebonne Parish detectives continued the investigation regarding the burglaries that were reported to the Sheriff's Office on Saturday morning, January 28, 2012.

On Saturday morning TPSO detectives arrested Nathan Hebert for one count of simple burglary. Hebert remained in jail on a \$50,000.00 bond. Then, after further investigation Hebert was charged with several more crimes that were committed during this same time frame.

On Tuesday afternoon, Jan. 31, 2012, detectives charged Hebert with two counts of simple burglary of a vehicle, two counts of simple burglary of an inhabited dwelling, two counts of theft under \$500, possession of control dangerous substance IV (xanax), possession of synthetic marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia (glass pipe, scale, etc.).

All of the residence and vehicles burglaries occurred in the 500 block of Louis Dr. Detectives recovered property that was stolen from the vehicles and residences such as tools, stereo equipment, a pressure washer, lawn edger, a motorized scooter, a dart game etc. There was a shopping cart located inside of a closet in Herbert's apartment that contained some of the stolen items. Inside of Hebert apartment detectives also located the drugs mentioned in the above paragraph.

Nathan Christopher Hebert, age-19, 400 Westside Boulevard Houma remains in jail on \$100,000.00 bond. This investigation is ongoing and more arrest is subject to follow.
