On November 14, 2010, Sunday morning at approximately 7:30 a.m. Terrebonne Parish deputies responded to Sarah's Convenient Store located at 5219 Grand Caillou Rd. in reference to a disturbance.

Deputies arrived at this location and contacted the manager of the store who advised that the suspect, who is a regular customer, went to the store and destroyed their property for an unknown reason. The suspect flipped over two news paper vending machines destroyed the front glass door to the business and damaged the store's surveillance cameras. The total damage was over \$1,000.00.

Deputies made contact with the suspect who was still at the location. The suspect is identified as Randall Patrick Dean. He advised deputies that he had just returned from New Orleans where he and his brother had been drinking all night. He stated that he and his brother got into an argument and he became angry. He stated that he then punched the front glass door causing it to shatter, furthermore, flipped over the two news paper vending machines and destroyed the surveillance cameras.

Randall Patrick Dean, age-25, 106 Panda Lane, was arrested for simple criminal damage to property. He was transported to the Terrebonne Parish Jail where he was booked and jailed. Dean was released from jail on Sunday afternoon after posting a \$500 cash bond.
