A Schriever man was arrested Thursday afternoon in connection with intentionally injuring his infant son, Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said.

A complaint was filed on April 27 by medical staff from a local hospital in reference to an infant who was being treated for multiple skull fractures. Detectives were initially advised that the father of the four month old infant accidentally dropped the child while caring for it. Further investigation and additional medical evidence received after the child was transported to a New Orleans Hospital revealed that the injuries were not attributed to an accidental incident.

The parents of the child, who are not married, were interviewed on Thursday. The father, identified as Terry Lee Victor, 19 of 140 Octavia Street in Schriever, admitted to intentionally throwing the infant to the ground twice while caring for it. He cited anger issues as the reason for the violence against the child. It was determined that the mother was not involved in the crime.

The child has been released from medical care and is currently in foster care.

Victor was arrested and charged with one count of second degree cruelty to a juvenile. He is being held at the Terrebonne Parish Criminal Justice Complex awaiting a bond hearing.
