A Schriever man was arrested Monday night in connection with the murder of his girlfriend, Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said.

At approximately 1200 hrs., the Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office received a call in reference to a partially clad female body found in a ditch on Hwy 309 (also known as Brule Guilliot Road). The body was found by three subjects who were fishing in the area. Upon the arrival of patrol officers, it was determined that the body was actually located in Lafourche parish.

The Lafourche Parish Sheriff's Office detectives began the investigation into what appeared to be a murder of the female. The female had an apparent gunshot wound to the chest and had been in the ditch for an undetermined amount of time. With the assistance of TPSO crime scene investigators, the female was identified through fingerprints as Sherry Gautreaux, a 42 year old subject from Raceland.

It was further learned that the female had an on-going relationship with a Schriever resident. At that time, TPSO and LPSO began a joint investigation into Gautreaux's murder.

The investigation led detectives to question Gautreaux's boyfriend, Darryl Ansardi, 58 of 179 John Edward Lane in Schriever. An interview of Ansardi revealed that Ansardi shot Gautreaux inside his residence in late February and he disposed her body in the ditch where it was subsequently located.

Ansardi was booked early Tuesday morning at the Terrebonne Parish Criminal Justice Complex for one count of second degree murder. No bond was set at the time of his arrest.

Ansardi and Gautreaux have a documented history of domestic violence situations with TPSO.
