Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office detectives arrested two Thibodaux men in connection with a series of vehicle burglaries in Houma, Sheriff Vernon Bourgeois said.

In late December 2010, 17 residents in the Broadmoor Subdivision in west Houma reported that their vehicles were burglarized during the night. The burglaries occurred between December 23-27. Various items were taken from the unlocked vehicles including purses, electronic devices, money and other personal items. No suspect information was available during the initial investigations.

On Friday, January 7, 2011 detectives from the Thibodaux Police Department arrested four Thibodaux males for several vehicle burglaries in Thibodaux. TPSO subsequently questioned the suspects and connected two of the males to the Houma burglaries.

Trey Adam Waguespack, 20, of 1088 Hwy 1, was charged with 17 counts of simple burglary. He is currently incarcerated at the Lafourche Parish Detention Center.

Christopher Johnson, 21, of 409 Brandywine Drive, was charged with 17 counts of simple burglary. He is also being held at the Lafourche Parish Detention Center.

None of the stole items were recovered as the suspects involved admitted to selling the items to support their illegal narcotics habits.
